

DONATING BLOOD SAMPLES FOR COVID-19 RESEARCH WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT



Tested for COVID-19

POSITIVE RESULTS

You have tested positive for the COVID-19 virus and are currently infected or have recovered and are now symptom free.



Submit donor registration form

BE A PART OF THE CURE

If you're a match with a research study in your area, a Research Coordinator will contact you to discuss next steps.



Speak with Research Coordinator

GET ANSWERS TO YOUR QUESTIONS

During your scheduled call, you will walk through a short health screening, learn details about the study, provide your consent, and schedule a date and time for your 15-minute blood draw.



Schedule your sample donation

ON-LOCATION OR MOBILE

Your collection can take place at an on-site location in your area or we can schedule a sample collection in your home. The appointment will require about 15 minutes to collect a few tubes of blood.

What are the donor requirements?

CONFIRM POSITIVE RESULTS

- Currently have or previously had COVID-19
- Have documentation of a positive COVID-19 test result
- Are at least 18 years old with a photo ID
- Meet any other eligibility criteria specific to the selected research study
- Be willing to sign a consent form for your participation in a research study
- Willing to disclose if you have ever been diagnosed with Hepatitis B, C and/or HIV.
- Willing to provide a few tubes of blood

How long will all of this take?

TIME COMMITMENT IS MINIMAL

Your scheduled call with the Research Coordinator should only take about 10–15 minutes. On the day of collection, you will be donating just a few tubes of blood, which should take no more than 15 minutes.

Will I be selected to donate for a research study?

MANY DONORS ARE NEEDED

There are currently many research projects that need sample donations. Various factors may influence whether you are selected for a project, including when you were diagnosed, where you are in your recovery, where you live, as well as your age and gender.

Will my blood donation make a difference?

YOUR SUPPORT IS KEY

Scientists desperately need blood from COVID-19 patients for their research. Your sample donation will contribute to a better understanding of COVID-19 and may ultimately lead to new tests, treatments, and vaccines for the disease.
